



IB Diploma Subject Grid 2026-2028 (Draft June 2026)

Subjects are organized according to the IB Diploma subject groups. IB students should select one subject from each of the six columns, choosing 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL).

Subjects in the same vertical column are taught at the same time, hence only one subject from each column can be chosen.

Notes: *For timetable reasons, selecting HL Mathematics with HL English is not possible.*

All students must take one Language A course in either Group 1 or Group 2. Students can study two Language A courses at either level or one Language A and one Language B at either level.

SSST Language A SL: School-supported, self-taught language A courses at Standard Level are also offered. Please discuss this option with Mrs Fairley if you are interested in taking a course in your native language as part of your IB Diploma.

+Theatre and Dance may only be offered if a sufficient number of students choose it.

German students wishing to comply with KMK regulations need to take Mathematics OR Bio/Chem/Phys OR a language at HL. They should take two languages, one an A course and one a B course (Latin and *ab initio* courses are not Language B options). All subjects listed above in group 3 are accepted by the KMK. It is advised that students seek advice on their subject choices with the universities or educational authorities of their region.

The School reserves the right to adjust the subject grid and setting as necessary throughout the School year. This may impact the subjects available to prospective pupils and/or the timetables and sets of current pupils. Students should pick THREE subjects, no more than ONE subject from EACH column below. Some students will do FOUR subjects in agreement with the Head of Upper School or Director of Studies.

Please note that it is possible to study **two or three A levels alongside one Higher Level IB Language course from French, Spanish, German or Latin** – please talk to the Head of Upper School or Director of Studies if you want more information about this.

Following current advice from university Admissions Departments, the School does not recommend that pupils take Business and Economics at A Level.

+If you wish to study **A-level Further Mathematics**, please select 'Maths and Further Maths' in both columns B and E. The course includes A-level Mathematics. Further Mathematics **must** be taken as a fourth A-level.

^BTEC Sport and Exercise Science must be selected in both columns A and B, as it is the equivalent to two A-level courses.

~BTEC Business Management is the equivalent to one A-level subject.

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
